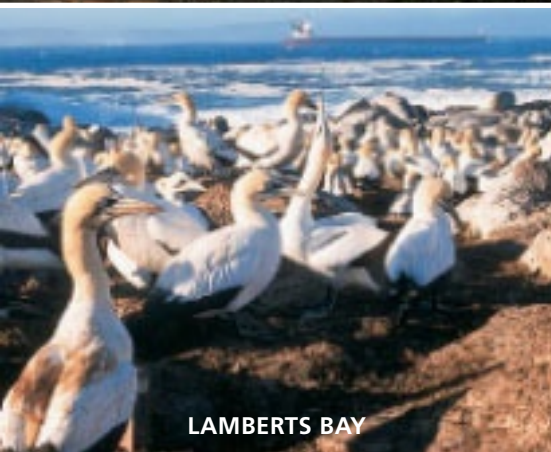

other places of interest

- **BOUCHARD FINLAYSON VINEYARD:** A boutique winery in the lovely Hemel-en-Aarde valley (Heaven and Earth), part of the Walker Bay wine region near Hermanus, South Africa's whale-watching capital. Acclaimed worldwide for producing the best Pinot Noir in SA, as well as exceptional Chardonnays and Sauvignon Blanc.
- **CLANWILLIAM MUSEUM:** The old prison at the end of the Main Road is a fascinating Museum with old Voortrekker wagons and many other artefacts from the time of the pioneers. The history of Clanwilliam and of the Rooibos Tea production is also documented here. The museum is open only on weekdays from 8am to 12pm.
- **ROOIBOS TEA COMPANY:** The Rooibos Tea Company offers an interesting video and a sample of their tea. If you'd like to see a tea producing farm, you can visit the farm Elandsberg on the road to Lambert's Bay near Graafwater. Here you can see how the tea is cultivated, harvested and fermented.
- **CEDERBERG HERITAGE ROUTE:** The Cederberg Heritage Route offers a collection of four community-based hiking trails in the Cederberg mountains. If you do not wish to do one of the official hiking trails, you can take the Donkey Cart Adventure from the Pakhuis Pass to Heuningvlei.
- **CEDERBERG WINES:** Cederberg wines are produced by South Africa's most uniquely situated wine farm boasting the Cape's highest lying vineyards. The farm is situated in the Cederberg Wilderness Area, and falls within the Cape "fynbos" region - one of the worlds' six floral kingdoms.
- **WUPPERTHAL:** Visit the old Rhenish Mission Station of Wuppertal, which dates back to 1834. It is an attractive little oasis in the very heart of the rugged wilderness of the Cederberg and the Tatra Mountains. The village is famous for its little shoe factory producing the famous hand-made "Veld Skoene". Access from Clanwilliam via the Pakhuis Pass. The road is quite rough, but if you drive slowly it's accessible with a normal car.
- **LAMBERTS BAY:** This humble seaside fishing village is one of the major tourist attractions on the West Coast due to its moderate all year round climate. The Sandveld Museum and nearby local farms like Wadrift, will open your mind to the cultural history of this unique place.

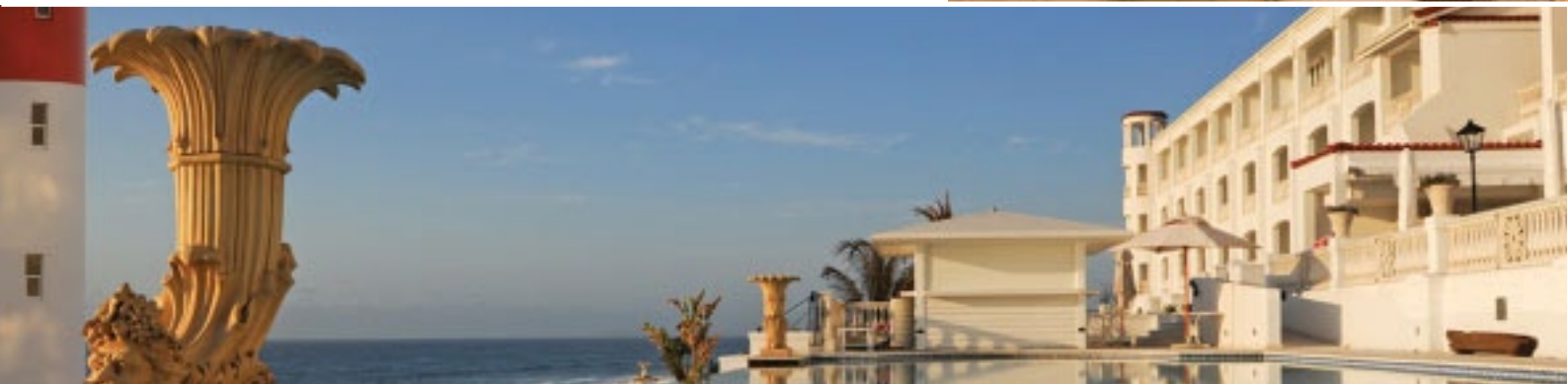
